The Tourism Enhancement Fund (TEF) invites tenders from suitably qualified entities to carry **Architectural, Civil/Structural, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Quantity Surveying, Contract Administration, Land Surveying and Project Management Services**.

Scope of Works

The Tourism Enhancement Fund (TEF) has decided to develop the **Alligator Pond Beach, St. Elizabeth, under the TEF Beaches Programme** to include at a minimum and where applicable, the construction of changing and restroom facilities, installation of perimeter fence, parking area, gazebos, bandstands and children play area, seating, walkways, landscaping, lighting, water supply, sewage treatment and provide shoreline protection (where applicable). Beach should also have a unique architectural feature.
