- A valid Public Procurement Commission (PPC), formerly NCC registration in the categories of:
  - o Motor Vehicle & Spares AND
  - o Motor Vehicles Spares and Accessories
- Tender Security in the amount and format specified
- Completed, signed and sealed Form of Tender.

Additional requirements are outlined in the criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Tender documents can be downloaded as of Monday, November 25, 2019.
- Clarification period no later than 7 working days (Monday, December 30, 2019) before bid submission deadline.

Submission deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via GOJEP no later than Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at 11:00 a.m.

Bids will be opened using the online platform; as such, there will not be a public tender opening exercise. The system will forward the tender opening report to all bidders who submitted bid proposal.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security MUST be submitted in hard copy to the National Water Commission (NWC) and delivered by **Thursday**, **January 9**, **2020 at 11:00 a.m.** at the following address:
