The National Irrigation Commission Limited, as one of its strategic objectives for the Financial Year 2019-2020, will be implementing a number of projects to increase pumping and conveyance efficiencies. This project will see the NIC providing peak pressurized irrigation water to service 141.6 hectares of land under vegetable production.
