The National Irrigation Commission Limited (NIC) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the above-captioned procurement opportunity: supply, installation and commissioning of sand media filtration assemblies, pumps, motors, pump manifolds and motor control centres at the Innswood Pumping Station located in St. Catherine. The National Irrigation Commission Limited, as one of its strategic objectives for the Financial Year 2019-2020, will be implementing a number of projects to increase pumping and conveyance efficiencies. This project will see the NIC providing peak pressurized irrigation water to service 141.6 hectares of land under vegetable production.

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received loan financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) towards the cost of the Strategic Public Sector Transformation Project (SPSTP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the selection of a **Project Analyst Consultant for the Public Investment Management Secretariat (PIMSEC)**.

The Government has committed to strengthen Jamaica's Public Investment Management System (PIMS), as part of a comprehensive public financial management (PFM reform) agenda. PIMSEC is the 'Gatekeeper' of the entire system and the mandate of PIMSEC is to undertake the technical analysis of concepts and proposals and advise the reviewing bodies of their feasibility and sustainability among other selection criteria – social and economic cost benefit, environmental impact, etc.

The primary role of the **Project Analyst Consultant** in the PIMSEC will be to ensure that only well prepared, sound projects are referred for selection. The Consultant will be engaged for twelve (12) months with the option of renewal upon satisfactory performance.
