The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of Strategic Public Sector Transformation Project (SPSTP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the selection of a **Firm to Conduct Training in Software Development.**

The consulting service ("the Services") includes developing a programme to provide the requisite software development training to participants whose roles involve designing and coding application software and also the sourcing, scheduling and delivering specialized software development training courses as outlined in the detailed Terms of Reference. The consultancy will be executed over **Seven (7) months, non-consecutive days.**

The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service now invites eligible Consulting Firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criterion is:

- At least 8 years' experience in working with large organizations to deliver on similar scope.

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016, Revised November 2017 and August 2018 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultant's Qualification Selection (CQS) Method set out in the Procurement Regulations. The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for **ROAD REHABILITATION OF ROSEWELL ROAD, LOCATED IN THE PARISH OF CLARENDON**. The works consist of demolition and site clearance, drain cleaning and construction pavement works such as base course, prime coat and asphaltic concrete overlay 38mm thick.

Eligibility: It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC)/ Public Procurement Commission (PPC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grade 1 or 2 in the Civil Engineering Works or General Road Works Categories.
