The Government of Jamaica (GOJ), through the United Nations Environment Programme, has received financing from the Global Environment Facility (GEF). The GOJ intends to apply part of the proceeds to implement the National Sub-Project 1.4 Biodiversity Mainstreaming in Coastal landscapes within the Negril Environmental Protection Area of Jamaica, for the engagement of an **Individual Consultant. The Individual Consultant** will undertake a population assessment of the West Indian Whistling Duck (WIWD) within the boundaries of the Negril Environmental Protection Area.

The National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA), the executing agency for the project, now invites eligible individual consultant ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in undertaking the **WIWD** consultancy. The purpose of this consultancy is to (but not limited to) undertake identifying the important sites for the population within the Negril EPA to include possible breeding and foraging areas; identifying the threats to the population; recommend ecosystem restoration measures and sites (with a focus on the Negril Great Morass) which require restoration to accommodate the West Indian Whistling Duck; develop a conservation strategy for the management of the West Indian Whistling Duck population in the Negril EPA; and estimate the present West Indian Whistling Duck population in the Negril EPA

An Individual Consultant will be selected in accordance with the GOJ Public Sector Procurement Procedures: Selection Based on the Consultants' Qualification (CQS).
