- The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Youth Employment in the Digital & Animation Industries Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for the **Rehabilitation of the Mount Salem Community Centre**.
- The Office of the Prime Minister now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Rehabilitation of the Mount Salem Community Centre which include the proposed renovation and alteration of the existing concrete structure, inclusive of the extension of an existing space to be used for a computer lab complete with the installation concrete roof slab, electrical installation, solar system installation, air conditioning, and minor landscaping works.
- Bidding will be conducted through national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" 2016 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
