The Development Bank of Jamaica (DBJ), through the Government of Jamaica (GoJ), has received financing from the World Bank and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan towards the Access to Finance for Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (MSMEs) Project, specifically to Component 2: Supporting a Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SME) Fund for risk capital financing.

This Call for Proposals (CFP) is being issued for a Fund Manager, with the capability of raising matching private capital and undertaking investments in Jamaican SMEs.

The DBJ administers the Jamaica Venture Capital Programme (JV Capital), and is the project implementing entity for the Access to Finance for MSMEs Project. DBJ is a member, and the lead anchor investor, of the Investor Panel (Jamaican corporate and institutional investors), which seeks to select a Fund Manager for the establishment and management of an SME Fund, in Jamaica or another eligible jurisdiction.
