The selected firm will also be responsible for recommending additional equipment (servers, scanners etc.) that will be deemed necessary for the deployment of the software application.

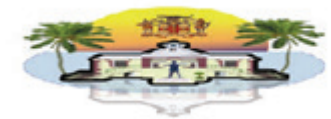
