In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen and promote Public Procurement, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOF&PS), Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP) is on a drive to expand the use of the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement System (GOJEP) to its suppliers of goods, services and works.

A mandatory Site Visit will be held on Tuesday, February 25, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., at the Petrojam Limited's Kingston Refinery located at 96 Marcus Garvey Drive Kingston 15. The failure of a bidder to attend the mandatory site visit will result in rejection of the bid.
