The South St. Elizabeth region in Jamaica is primarily known for its agricultural activities, wide array of resorts, beaches and popular tourist attractions and possesses an unlimited potential for rapid, inclusive and sustained economic growth and development. A number of major developments further compound the economic growth potential of this area.

In light of the foregoing, it is envisaged that road improvements or enhancements in the South St. Elizabeth area will become necessary to ensure seamless transportation and movement of equipment, goods and people.

The purpose of this contract is to conduct a comprehensive traffic study to analyse existing road use trends, project future road use patterns and propose a solution that will provide a solid base for sustainable planning and improvement of the South St. Elizabeth road network.
