- Spectrum Management Authority (SMA) has secured funding to procure a 225KVA Standby Generator for its offices located at 13-19 Harbour Street, Kingston. This will enable the SMA to maintain productivity in the event of any disruption in the public power supply.
- Spectrum Management Authority hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced Contractors to submit proposals for the Supply and Installation of a Standby Generator and Automatic Transfer Switch in accordance with the Technical Specifications.

- National Competitive Bidding

Eligibility:

- Proof of valid registration with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) in the Category: Electrical Equipment, Parts and Supplies or Industrial, Construction Equipment & Machinery, Parts and Supplies at minimum grade 3 level Contractor.

The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”)

The South St. Elizabeth region in Jamaica is primarily known for its agricultural activities, wide array of resorts, beaches and popular tourist attractions and possesses an unlimited potential for rapid, inclusive and sustained economic growth and development. A number of major developments further compound the economic growth potential of this area.

In light of the foregoing, it is envisaged that road improvements or enhancements in the South St. Elizabeth area will become necessary to ensure seamless transportation and movement of equipment, goods and people.

The **purpose** of this contract is to conduct a comprehensive traffic study to analyse existing road use trends, project future road use patterns and propose a solution that will provide a solid base for sustainable planning and improvement of the South St. Elizabeth road network.

The anticipated duration of the assignment is nine (9) months.
