The GOJ intends to apply part of the proceeds to implement the National Sub-Project 1.4 Biodiversity Mainstreaming in Coastal Landscapes within the Negril Environmental Protection Area of Jamaica, for the engagement of an **Individual Consultant. The Individual Consultant will prepare a Wetlands Management Plan for the Negril Environmental Protection Area to include an implementation plan and budget.**

The National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA), the executing agency for the project, now invites eligible individual consultants ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in undertaking the **Wetlands Management Plan** consultancy. The purpose of this consultancy is to (but not limited to) develop a wetland land use management plan and strategy to enhance functions/services based on desired habitat requirements for increasing associated species and improving water quality and flow; provide information on the status and extent of mangrove areas within the Negril EPA; determine priority areas for conservation, restoration, rehabilitation and further detailed studies, excluding the Negril Great Morass; and identify current issues/problems affecting the resource.
