PREQUALIFICATION FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF CORNWALL REGIONAL HOSPITAL (CRH) REHABILITATION PROGRAMME PHASE 3 PRIORITY WORKS

Ministry of Health & Wellness now invites proposals from eligible and qualified companies for the Cornwall Regional Hospital Rehabilitation Programme which has become necessary following substantial environmental problems affecting the building's users and the need to redevelop and upgrade the facilities to meet acceptable international and local standards. The proposed works consist of the comprehensive redevelopment and rehabilitation of an existing approximately 33,300 m² (358,500 ft²) 10-floor hospital building constructed in 1974 located at Mount Salem, Montego Bay, St. James, Jamaica.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) Procedures specified in the Government of Jamaica procurement policies.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible, an Applicant must:

1. Demonstrate that it is Tax Compliant in its country of origin
2. Not have a conflict of interest as defined in ITB 6.4 and declare same by submitting the completed Application Submission Form
3. Submit its business registration or incorporation certificate
4. Complete the Litigation Form provided.

Preference will be given in the bidding stage to companies that are willing to do joint ventures with Jamaican works contractors.
