The Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation (MEGJC) invites Proposals for the provision of Consultancy services to revise the CIPJ document and develop a corresponding Implementation Plan.

The general objective of the revised CIPJ is to provide a comprehensive framework that facilitates the growth of the construction sector and by extension, the country. The revised CIPJ is expected to strengthen institutional mechanisms and operational processes within the sector and in doing so ensure congruence among all relevant policies and legislation. The revised Policy is also expected to facilitate industry competitiveness in local, regional and international markets and as such, emphasis will be placed on the use of environmentally sustainable practices which take into consideration climate change mitigation and adaptation; integration of technology and the development of human resources in the sector. The interest, health and safety of workers in the industry will be promoted while making provisions for minority groups.

It is intended that the revised CIPJ will remain anchored in the Vision 2030: National Development Plan's broader development structure and form the basis of collaboration and coordinated action among key stakeholders, including government agencies, the private sector, professional bodies and academia.

Eligibility Requirements:

Consultants must provide proof of membership in a Professional Organization in the construction sector and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC).
