

THE DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT ACT

The Disaster Risk Management (Enforcement Measures) (No. 3) (Amendment) Order, 2020

WHEREAS the Minister responsible for disaster preparedness and emergency management has given written notice to the Prime Minister that Jamaica appears to be threatened with or affected by the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19), and that measures apart from or in addition to those specifically provided for in the Disaster Risk Management Act should be taken promptly:

AND WHEREAS on March 13, 2020, the Prime Minister by Order declared the whole of Jamaica to be a disaster area:

NOW THEREFORE:

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Prime Minister by section 26(2) of the Disaster Risk Management Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:-


1. This Order may be cited as the Disaster Risk Management (Enforcement Measures) (No. 3) (Amendment) Order, 2020, and shall be read and construed as one with the Disaster Risk Management (Enforcement Measures) (No. 3)

Order, 2020, hereinafter referred to as the principal Order, and all amendments thereto.

2. Paragraph 12 of the principal Order is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (2)(a) and substituting therefor the following –

“(a) to a person referred to in paragraph 11(3)(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p), (q), (r), (s), (t), (u), (v), (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa) or (bb) or for the purposes as referred to in that paragraph;”.
