**Eligibility Requirements:**

**Tenderers must submit:**

- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
- A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission formerly (NCC) in any of the following categories at the bid submission deadline:
  - General Supplies specializing in Pipe and Fittings OR
  - Industrial Pipes & Fittings
- Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
- Bid security in the correct amount and form

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.
