The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received loan financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) towards the cost of the Strategic Public Sector Transformation Project (SPSTP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the consulting services. The Project Development Objective (PDO) is to strengthen public resource management and support selected public sector institutions in facilitating a more enabling environment for private sector growth.

The Government therefore intends to allocate part of the funding under the IBRD loan for the purpose of developing Jamaica's Time and Frequency Measurement Capabilities by fully equipping the Time and Frequency Laboratory of the Bureau of Standards Jamaica.

The services to be offered by the newly developed Time and Frequency Laboratory will facilitate the implementation of the Time-Stamping of Financial Transactions, among many others. In tandem with the development of the laboratory capabilities, the Government also intends to allocate part of the funding under the IBRD loan for a consultancy to conduct a legislative review for the purpose of the time-stamping project.

The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service now invites eligible individuals to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy service. Interested individuals should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the service. The shortlisting criteria are:

- Postgraduate degree in Law with speciality in Legislative Drafting.
- At least 10 years' experience in the development of drafting instructions and /or legislative drafting.
