Assignment Title: CONSULTING SERVICES - TRANSACTION ADVISOR SITING STUDY FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT PPP PROJECT

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ), through the Development Bank of Jamaica (DBJ), intends to procure a qualified firm or a consortium of experts as Transaction Advisors to assist in structuring and implementing a competitive tender process to select a reputable private investor for a Proposed Integrated Solid Waste Management Project on a design, build, finance, maintain, operate and transfer basis.

The Consulting Services ("the Services")

The GOJ has identified solid waste disposal as a priority problem and requires assistance in the siting of a new sanitary landfill and waste-to-energy (WTE) facility in the Kingston Metropolitan Area and recommendation of sites for transfer stations.

The Siting Study should include an initial screening of at least six (6) potential sites and then shall identify at least three (3) candidate sites which are technically, economically, and environmentally suitable, as well as potentially socially and politically acceptable for development into sanitary landfill and a WTE facility. These three (3) candidate sites shall be further analysed and one (1) site recommended for design and usage.
