The Accountant General's Department (AGD) is the Treasury of Jamaica. It is an operational department in the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service and is charged with facilitating and reporting on the flow of funds into and from the Consolidated Fund which is the principal instrument of Parliamentary control of public moneys.

In view of the critical role the AGD plays in the success of the Public Financial Management (PFM) initiatives, and the strides that the AGD has made over the years towards modernising which include a reorganised organisational structure with some core treasury functions including cash management transferred to the Department, the AGD seeks staff members who must be prepared to operate efficiently and ethically in the treasury.

Consequently, there needs to be robust vetting of new recruits to ensure that the treasury is staffed with personnel of high integrity, thus reducing the risk of fraud.

The Security Vetting Officer is therefore expected to have all new recruits to the Accountant General's Department properly vetted and declared as fit for purpose.

The AGD now invites eligible individuals to provide Curriculum Vitae with detailed information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications, relevant experience, and competence to perform the required service.
