Description of Service:

Supply & Delivery of 100mm, 300mm & 400mm, Nom. Dia. Ductile Iron (DI) Pipes and associated Appurtenances for various locations.

Eligibility Requirements:

Tenderers must submit:

- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
- A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission, formerly (NCC) in any of the following categories at the bid submission deadline:
 - General Supplies specializing in Pipe and Fittings OR
 - Industrial Pipes & Fittings
- Completed, signed and sealed form of tender
- Bid security in the correct amount and form
- A Power of Attorney (POA) document is required if the company's bid is not signed by a Director or Chief Executive Officer of the company.

Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the Bidding Document.

Availability of Bid document and Bid Submission:

This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- The Tender documents can be downloaded as of **Thursday, July 16, 2020**.
- Clarification period – no later than 7 working days (**Friday, August 7, 2020**) before bid submission deadline.

Submission deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via GOJEP no later than **August 18, 2020 at 11:00 a.m.**

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

The original Bid Security MUST be submitted in hard copy to the Tender Box at the National Water Commission (NWC) delivered by **Wednesday, August 19, 2020 at 11:00 a.m.** at the following address:

Assignment Title: CONSULTING SERVICES - TRANSACTION ADVISOR SITING STUDY FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT PPP PROJECT

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ), through the Development Bank of Jamaica (DBJ), intends to procure a qualified firm or a consortium of experts as Transaction Advisors to assist in structuring and implementing a competitive tender process to select a reputable private investor for a Proposed Integrated Solid Waste Management Project on a design, build, finance, maintain, operate and transfer basis.

The Consulting Services ("the Services")

The GOJ has identified solid waste disposal as a priority problem and requires assistance in the siting of a new sanitary landfill and waste-to-energy (WTE) facility in the Kingston Metropolitan Area and recommendation of sites for transfer stations.

The Siting Study should include an initial screening of at least six (6) potential sites and then shall identify at least three (3) candidate sites which are technically, economically, and environmentally suitable, as well as potentially socially and politically acceptable for development into sanitary landfill and a WTE facility. These three (3) candidate sites shall be further analysed and one (1) site recommended for design and usage.
