The Provision of HIV Prevention Services in Support of the National HIV Response

The Ministry of Health & Wellness (MOHW) now invites interested eligible consultancy firms to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) to provide Consultancy Services for the Provision of HIV Prevention Services in Support of the National HIV Response.

Since 1986, the National HIV/STI/TB Programme has been coordinating and leading the national response in collaboration with the Regional Health Authorities (RHAs). Recognizing the key role of the entire society in the response, the Ministry of Health & Wellness is seeking to partner with Private Sector, NGOs and CSOs to improve delivery of HIV services to key and vulnerable populations using social contracting. This will be the mechanism for engaging entities to reach their target population in a more efficient and effective manner that contributes to the sustainability of these organizations providing HIV services and the fulfilment of the objectives outlined in the national strategic plan.

Qualification & Experience:

Interested entities must satisfy the following requirements:

- The organization must be registered with the Company's Office of Jamaica and/or the Department of Co-operatives and Friendly Societies.
- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) and/or Tax Compliance Letter (TCL)
- Submit an application letter and an outline of the organization's prospectus detailing their work in the area of HIV or related interventions. The document should detail:
 - At least three (3) projects successfully implemented in any social intervention area
 - At least two (2) projects implemented in HIV/STI interventions in the last 5 years
 - At least one (1) project successfully implemented in the last two (2) years targeting prevention strategies in the key populations
- Must have procedures in place that maintain client's confidentiality that are consistent with the delivery of these services. Inspection of facilities may be required.

The organization is expected to have in place appropriate financial and project management systems.

Consultancy firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-based Selection process as outlined in the Guidelines for Government Procurement Procedures.
