For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.
2. The Office of the Prime Minister now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for supply of **Substance Painter Software (Schools, ASAP)**.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive procurement using Request for Quotation (RFQ) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
