The Clarendon Municipal Corporation now invites sealed bids from eligible CONTRACTORS for the proposed Rehabilitation of Bushy Park Housing Scheme Roadway, Clarendon.

SCOPE OF WORKS:

The scope of works includes but not limited to reconstruction base, sub-base drainage works, pavement upgrade including scarifying and placement of base and application of asphaltic concrete as wearing course.

It is mandatory that contractors be registered with the Public Procurement Commission in the Category "General Roadworks/Civil Engineering Works" Grade 2 and above. All bidders must be tax compliant at the time of the bid opening.
