3. Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive procurement using Request for Quotation (RFQ) as specified in the World Bank's 'Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers' July 2016 ('Procurement Regulations'), and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
