The Kingston and St. Andrew Municipal Council (KSAMC) now invites eligible and qualified companies to submit sealed proposals for the **Development and Renovation of the Papine Market**.

**Project Outline:** Papine Market sits on a 34,000 ft<sup>2</sup> of land within the "University District". It has become a hub of activity for pedestrians, transportation operations, business owners and students. Several residential communities that surround the area further add to the sheer volume of persons who pass through on a daily basis. The current state of the Papine Market offers an opportunity to develop the area into a major commercial centre that offers the necessary and accessible services for the local population.

The Market has been well established for years and has become a major part of the culture of the area. In order to keep a bit of the culture intact, it is important to improve upon it, elevating it into becoming a much safer and more organized system of operations which ultimately leads to a greater appreciation.

The new facility must include a larger scale area dedicated to the Market, areas for commercial facilities, accessible entrances and walkways for differently-abled bodies, sufficiently sized restrooms, sufficient parking, shopping/delivery access, and appropriate solid waste disposal plan.
