Scope:

The Ministry of Tourism is seeking a firm/consultant (s) with proven tourism experience to conduct a Disaster Preparedness Assessment and develop a Disaster Risk Management Plan Template and Guidelines for the tourism sector.

Scope: The National Health Fund, an agency of the Ministry of Health & Wellness, Jamaica, now invites bids from eligible bidders for the periodic supply of pharmaceutical preparations, as listed in the Schedule of Requirements of the tender documents, for a 36-month contract period, for use in JADEP Provider Pharmacies across the island.

Format: Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding process specified in the Government of Jamaica, Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures http://www.mof.gov.jm and is open to all bidders from all countries. Ferry Desalination Water Treatment Plant & Renewable Energy System Project, St. Catherine International Competitive Bidding

Procuring Entity: The National Water Commission

Description of Service:

By way of International Competitive Bidding, the National Water Commission (NWC) is inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) from local and international firms, with strong capabilities, experienced and qualified personnel in the water and civil engineering works/infrastructure, pipeline installation works to undertake the construction of a Desalination water treatment plant, transmission mains installation, electromechanical/pumping stations and renewable energy systems.

This project is a part of the NWC's long-term strategy and its Capital Investment Improvement Programme to satisfy and fulfil water supply requirements for Ferry and adjoining communities within the Parish.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must prepare and submit responses as well as the forms that are contained in the EOI document. Additional requirements are outlined in the criteria used for evaluation in the EOI document. Based on the results of the evaluation of responses, and the process outlined to pre-qualify firms, the shortlisted firms will be selected. The shortlisted firms will then be invited to submit Financial and Technical Proposals to carry out the Implementation of the Ferry Desalination Water Treatment Plant & Renewable Energy System.

Note that prior to the award of contract at the next and final (Request For Proposal) stage, the successful firm(s) will be required to have valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/ Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) and valid Public Procurement Commission (PPC)/National Contracts Commission (NCC) registration in ALL of the following categories:

- 1. Grade 1 – Pipe Laying
- 2. Grade 1 – Civil Engineering Works
- 3. Grade 1 – Electrical Works
- 4. Grade 1 – Mechanical Works
- 5. Renewable Energy Systems

Firms may amalgamate to form a combination to carry out this project in accordance with the form of association(s) stated in the EOI document.

Availability of Bid document and Bid Submission:

This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- The EOI documents can be downloaded as of Thursday, July 2, 2020.
- Clarification period – no later than 7 working days (August 3, 2020) before EOI submission deadline.

Submission deadline: Tenders must be submitted via GOJEP no later than Thursday, August 13, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. (Jamaica time)

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.
