#### MEDAL OF HONOUR FOR GALLANTRY

#### Superintendent of Police Leon Ernest Clunis (Posthumous award)

Superintendent Clunis courageously led a deadly operation in Horizon Park, St Catherine, where he was shot. He was hospitalised and due to related complications succumbed to injuries on June 30, 2020. Supt Clunis was part of an intelligence-driven operation mounted on the morning of Friday, June 12, 2020, in search of wanted men with high-powered weapons. The perpetrator who fired upon the Police was killed hours later in a police operation.

#### **Detective Corporal Dane Kimoy Biggs**

#### (Posthumous award)

Detective Corporal Biggs lost his life heroically during a deadly operation conducted in Horizon Park, St Catherine, as part of an intelligence-driven operation mounted on the morning of Friday, June 12, 2020, in search of wanted men with high-powered weapons. The perpetrator who fired upon the police was killed hours later in a police operation.

#### **Constable Decardo Akeem Hylton** (Posthumous award)

Constable Hylton lost his life heroically during a deadly operation conducted in Horizon Park, St Catherine, as part of an intelligence-driven operation mounted on the morning of Friday, June 12, 2020, in search of wanted men with high-powered weapons. The perpetrator who fired upon the police was killed hours later in a police operation.

#### **District Constable Lothan Roshane Richards**

District Constable Richards suffered serious injuries when he was shot during a deadly operation conducted in Horizon Park, St Catherine, as part of an intelligence-driven operation mounted on the morning of Friday, June 12, 2020, in search of wanted men with high-powered weapons. He was hospitalised and later released. The perpetrator who fired upon the Police was killed hours later in a police operation.
