- Written Power of Attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder

Tenders submissions that do not comply with all the above requirement will be deemed non-responsive.

This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bid submission will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Portal – GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). **No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical drop box for drop-off of tender documents.**
