Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) Procedures specified in the Government of Jamaica procurement policies.

- Written Power of Attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder

The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to support the implementation of the hybrid operation consisting of a programmatic policy-based loan (PBP) (JA-L1080, 4669/OC-JA) and an investment loan (JA-L1049, 4668/OC-JA) for US\$50 million each that together comprise the "Support for the Health Systems Strengthening for the Prevention and Care Management of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) Programme"; and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the selection of a consulting firm.

The objective of the consultancy is to engage a highly experienced MEP/IT Firm who will be able to carry out MEP/IT Supervision and Implementation on thirteen (13) Health Facilities in specific areas slated for future upgrading and expansion.

The Ministry of Health & Wellness now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- Minimum Seven (7) years' experience with projects of MEP/IT-related government and non-government commercial projects
- Minimum Five (5) years' experience with similar projects of MEP/IT related to health facilities projects

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to 1.9 of the IDB's: Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank GN-2350-9, March 2011, setting forth the IDB's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) Method set out in the IDB's Policies.
