This is in keeping with the commitment of the Government to all procurement opportunities published and managed through GOJEP.

- Listing of contracts performed with similar scope over the last five (5) years
- Three (3) reference letters from organizations with which you have conducted similar business
- Listing of qualification and experience of Operational and Technical staff to be assigned to this contract
