Abstract:

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of National Security (MNS), is implementing the Security Strengthening Project (SSP) which is comprised of the following three (3) components:

- (i) **Violent crime prevention and management;**
- (ii) **Improving investigative capabilities for homicides and;**
- (iii) **Change Management and Communications.**

The Security Strengthening Project is aligned with the Sector Strategy on Institutions for Growth and Social welfare (GN-2587-2) and the Sector Framework for Citizen Security and Justice (OP-1201). The project is consistent with the 2016-2021 IDBG Country Strategy with Jamaica (GN-2868) and will contribute to the Corporate Results Framework (CRF) 2016-2019 (GN-2727-6) output indicators of: (i) Government agencies benefited by projects that strengthen technological and managerial tools to improve public service delivery; and (ii) Crime information systems strengthened. The project is also aligned with the 2017 Jamaica's Ministry of National Security Five Pillar Strategy for Crime Prevention and Citizen Security.

The Ministry of National Security *has received* financing from *the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB)*, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project Security Strengthening Project (SSP), for a Mobile Device Management System for the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF).

The Ministry of National Security now invites suitably qualified software vendors to submit proposals.

The Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF) is seeking a Mobile Device Management System to manage the mobile devices issued to police officers.

Scope:

The software must provide at a minimum the following:

- The management of mobile devices owned by the JCF, and registered on the JCF network.
- The management of BYOD registered on the JCF network.

A vendor will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank: Policies for the Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank GN-2349-9 for International Competitive Bidding. The selection will also be in accordance with the procurement policies of the Government of Jamaica.

Description of Consultancy Service:

By way of National Competitive Bidding, the National Water Commission (NWC) is inviting Request for Proposal (RFP) from local firms, with strong capabilities, experience and qualified personnel in financial audits with experience in the utility sector.

The consultant shall use nationally acceptable techniques and procedures to perform the following services:

1. Carry out the relevant audit procedures to verify the accuracy of the Financial Statements of the NWC.
2. Prepare an Audit Report expressing an opinion on the reasonableness of the Financial Statements.
3. Prepare a Management Letter identifying any deficiencies or areas of weakness in system controls and making recommendations for improvement.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must prepare and submit responses as well as the forms that are contained in the RFP document. Additional requirements are outlined in the Criteria used for evaluation in the RFP document. Based on the results of the evaluation of the Technical Proposal, the Financial Proposals of the shortlisted Firms will then be evaluated to identify the successful bidder.

Availability of RFP Document and RFP Submission: This is an online tender whereby tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Clarification period – no later than 7 working days (**Monday, November 16, 2020**) before RFP submission deadline.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.
