The Ministry of Health & Wellness/Health Promotion and Protection invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified Firms to Develop and Implement Social Marketing Campaign to Support the Implementation of Health Information Strategic Plan for NCDs in Jamaica 2020-2025.

The MOHW's 10-year strategic plan, Vision 2030, emphasizes the importance of addressing social determinants of Health (SDH) and health inequalities. The health promotion strategic plan for NCDs utilizes theoretical approaches that align it with Vision 2030 to address SDH and promote healthy behaviours in "the conditions in which people are born, grow, live, work and age." ¹ In addition, these approaches, the Social Ecological Mode and the Life Course Concept, reflect the current direction of MOHW health promotion to reduce risk factors for NCDs.
