- Develop configuration rules, test scenarios, interface/ integration specifications, and data conversion.
- Undertake routine installation and de-installation of OmniSuite configurations and components.
- Identify project risks and implement or advise on mitigation strategies.
- Provision, install/configure user access, security levels, application software, related hardware and infrastructure.

The MOFPS invites eligible and qualified consultants to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy services.

The consultants will be selected in accordance with the Government of Jamaica Public Procurement Law.
