The Ministry of Health & Wellness/HIV/STI/TB (HST) invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified consultants to conduct the MSM Study Lead Survey. There is an urgent need in Jamaica to increase the effectiveness of prevention program among high-risk groups to limit the spread of HIV. Many approaches are needed to contain the epidemic, including school-based programs, mass media campaigns and targeted approaches for those most at risk. The prevention response needs strategic information in order to improve programs. This includes information about the prevalence of HIV and other STI. It also includes information about the characteristics and behaviours of the key populations.

CONSULTANT SERVICES TO ENGAGED EPIDEMIOLOGIST, EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SURVEILLANCE

The Ministry of Health & Wellness invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified consultants to engaged Epidemiologist, Epidemiological Surveillance. The Ministry of Health & Wellness seeks to strengthen the capacity for analysis of surveillance data at the national level. This is in recognition of the increased availability of data and need for rational use of data to inform interventions. This includes the use of data generated via routine disease/event based and sentinel surveillance systems as well as the identification and harnessing of non-traditional data sources. It is apparent in light of the recent outbreaks that a critical component of the national surveillance system has the ability to maintain capacity and remain resilient in the face of new public health threats.
