The budget of US\$700,000 is being administered through the Executing partners – UN Environment [Caribbean Sub-Regional Office, International Environmental Technology Centre (IETC), Global Programme of Action (GPA) for the Protection of the Marine Environment from Land-based Activities (Marine Litter)].
