DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

- St. Catherine High School Performing Arts Centre – 6 months

Construction of phase 1 of a two-storey performing arts centre building using a structural steel framework with infill concrete block walls. The building will include multipurpose areas, seating areas, stage and dressing/changing rooms, bathrooms and other amenities.

ELIGIBILITY:

It is mandatory that contractors be registered with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) in the category of "Building Construction" **Grade 2** and above.

All bidders must be **Tax Compliant** at the bid opening. Bidding will be in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Revised Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (March 2014).
