 - A detailed and costed Action Plan for the next 5 years, including a Risk Assessment, Results Framework and supporting indicators, and a Monitoring and Evaluation Plan to support the implementation of the Action Plan.

The Office of the Prime Minister (OPM) now invites eligible individuals ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services.
