Assignment Title: Consultancy to Support the Creation of the Digital Health Policy

The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) towards the cost of the Support for the Health Systems Strengthening for the Prevention and Care Management of Non-Communicable Diseases Programme, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") involves a review of the recommendations from PAHO and IDB and existing standards in the digital health ecosystem as: data exchange, interoperability standards, master patient index, electronic prescription, telemedicine, electronic health records and others. The implementation plan for the Policy Guidelines is to be developed for application and institutionalization at all levels of the public healthcare system. The assignment is for a duration of **twelve (12) months**.

The Ministry of Health & Wellness now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing the Services. The requirements are:

- A minimum Five (5) years' experience in Health Information System or Digital Health.
- At least Five (5) years' consulting/working experience in this field of work (Policymaking).
- A minimum of Five (5) years' experience in developing policies and programmes for health.
- Postgraduate qualifications in the Social Sciences with specialization in Public Administration/Public Sector Management, Public Financial Management, Policy, Development Studies, Management Studies, Operations Management, Economics, or a related discipline.
