2. Present a valid copy of the company Tax Compliance Letter (TCC/TCL). Letter must be supported with information pertaining to the expiry date of TCC.

Eligibility Requirements for International Suppliers

Applicants are required to submit a letter indicating their willingness to apply for the certification below should they be considered for the award of contract.

1. Public Procurement Commission (PPC), formerly known as the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in **Medical, Pharmaceutical Equipment and Supplies and/or Medical Equipment and Supplies** category and
2. Tax Compliance Letter (TCC/TCL).

Mandatory Requirements

- Completed and Signed Bid Submission Form
- Power of Attorney
- Bid Security valuing US\$60,796.75

To participate in this tender opportunity, bidders **must** first be registered on Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement (GOJEP) Portal at (www.gojep.gov.jm).

This is an online tender where bidding document, clarification and bid submission will only be made available and accepted via GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline copies will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop box for this opportunity.

- Clarification will be accommodated up to **February 1, 2021 at 3:00 p.m.**
