The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of Health and Wellness, has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) towards the cost of the Support for the Health Systems Strengthening for the Prevention and Care Management of Non-Communicable Diseases Programme, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the selection of a Monitoring and Evaluation (M & E) Specialist.

The M& E Specialist will (1) design and implement the overall monitoring and evaluation (M&E) framework and plan for the Project, including necessary instruments and tools; (2) Collect, compile, and analyze data on Intermediate, Project Development Objective indicators, and other relevant monitoring indicators (to be defined), as well as preparing all of the Project's M&E reports, in line with the Results Framework's specifications.

The Ministry of Health & Wellness now invites eligible individuals ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. The minimum requirements are:

- A Degree in Monitoring and Evaluation and/or professional certification in Monitoring and Evaluation or related field.
- At least 7 years of professional experience in the development of policy- and results- based M&E Frameworks and Plans and/or of performance-based management of international projects.
- At Least 4 years of experience in providing evaluation services and executing M&E activities including the implementation of M&E Frameworks and Plans.
- At least 3 years of experience in development planning and/ or related field
