ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF CONTRACTORS

To be considered eligible at the time of tender opening, your tender must include the following:

- Proof of valid registration with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC), in the Category: Building Construction -Grade 2
- Copy of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/Tax Compliance Letter (TCL)

Non-compliance with all or any of the two criteria above will result in an automatic disqualification of tender.

SCOPE OF WORKS

The purpose of this proposed refurbishing works is to modernize and improve access to the court building and the client experience of the Justice System. The works involved, but not limited to, external and internal painting; fixing and replacement of all existing windows and doors; extensive fixing and replacement of plumbing fixture and water supply installation; refinishing of wooden flooring; the installation of air-conditioning units including the cost of attendant electrical installation and the refurbishing of courtroom furniture.

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of Health & Wellness, has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDBs) towards the cost of the Support for the Health Systems Strengthening for the Prevention and Care Management of Non-Communicable Diseases Programme, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting

The consulting services ("the Services") are solicited to develop a detailed plan for managing the effects of organizational changes necessary for a transformed Healthcare sector that will provide the kind of efficiencies and services that are required and needed by the citizens of Jamaica and to work with change leaders to effectively include their input into the change management plan. The consultancy will have a duration of 24 months.

The Ministry of Health & Wellness now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The firm should meet the following criteria:

- At least seven years of experience working with large organizations to deliver on similar
- Should be able to provide evidence of the validity of experience and qualification, including work done for a healthcare organization.
- At least three years' experience working in multi-disciplinary organization and a multidisciplinary project.
- At least four years' experience as a Communications and Public Relations practitioner.
- At least three years' experience working as an ICT Specialist on a multidisciplinary

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank: Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank GN-2350-9 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Least Cost Selection Method set out in the IDB's Policies.
