In 2009, Jamaica launched, Vision 2030 Jamaica – National Development Plan (NDP), its first long term national development plan, which covers the 21-year period 2009-2030. Vision 2030 Jamaica was developed with the primary objective of providing a strategic framework to advance the achievement of developed country status towards ensuring a secure and prosperous future for all Jamaicans. The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Strategic Public Sector Transformation Project (SPSTP), and intends to apply a part of those proceeds towards the cost of engaging a consulting firm to Conduct Costing of the Medium-Term Socio-Economic Policy Framework.

The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service now invites eligible firms to submit their Expressions of Interests (EOIs) in providing the consultancy service. Interested firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the service. Required qualification and experience include:

- At least 5 years' experience in cost estimation on similar type assignments preferably in the Caribbean or similar regions;
- Minimum 3 years' experience in capacity building and training/professional development of a similar nature;
- Testimonials from at least three (3) previous clients.

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.
