SCOPE OF WORKS

The purpose of this proposed refurbishing works is to modernize and improve access to the court building and the client experience of the Justice System. The work involves, but is not limited to external and internal painting; fixing and replacement of all existing windows and doors; extensive fixing and replacement of plumbing fixture and water supply installation; refinishing of wooden flooring; the installation of air-conditioning units including the cost of attendant electrical installation and the refurbishing of courtroom furniture.

The Jamaica Urban Transit Company Limited (JUTC), a public transport company with registered offices at Michael Manley Drive, Twickenham Park, Spanish Town, St. Catherine, Jamaica and owned by the Jamaican Government, currently uses an electronic fare collection system (EFCS), which is at the end of its useful life.

In light of the above, the Company is required to conduct a market research in order to develop a comparative estimate of the price to expect from potential bidders to provide a new EFCS.

The JUTC now invites eligible individuals or firms, to indicate their interest in providing the Company with the necessary consultancy service, to conduct the relevant market research and compute a comparative estimate. Interested parties should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the service. The shortlisting criteria are:
