### INVITATION TO BID Republication (Extension of Deadline for Submission)

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) – United Kingdom Caribbean Infrastructure Partnership Fund (UKCIF), in an amount equivalent to £16,710,313 towards the cost of the Southern Plains Agricultural Development Project (SPAD) and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of GOJ and upon approval by CDB, will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOJ shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

The Ministry of Agriculture & Fisheries (MoAF), Southern Plains Agricultural Development Project (SPADP), now invited sealed bids from eligible and qualified Bidders for the Supply and Installation of Pumps and Equipment (MOAF/SPADP/W3/06/2021).

Firms whether bidding individually or in the form of a Joint Venture shall:

- (a) Be legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in an Eligible Country;
- (b) Be more than fifty (50) per cent beneficially owned by a citizen or citizens and/or a bona fide resident or residents of an Eligible Country, or by a body corporate or bodies meeting these requirements, as far as the ownership can be reasonably determined;
- (c) Have no arrangement and undertake not to make any arrangement whereby the majority of the financial benefits of the contract, i.e. more than fifty (50) per cent of the value of the contract, will accrue or be paid to subcontractors or sub-consultants that are not from an Eligible Country; and
- (d) In all cases, not be subject to any restrictions under European Council Regulation No 2580/2001 of 27 December 2001 or the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) 2009 of the UK with a view to combating terrorism.

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.

Eligible bidders will be required to submit full qualification information with their bids establishing their eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Tender and qualification information is to be submitted in the English language on the prescribed forms inserted in the Bid Documents. Submissions that do not provide the information required or that do not demonstrate the prospective contractor's ability to perform satisfactorily will not qualify and will not be considered for further evaluation.

Bid documents will be available for inspection at the first address below, from **June 25, 2021**, on weekdays between **9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Jamaican time**. The documents will be promptly issued in soft copy, but under no circumstance will GOJ SPADP, or MOAF be held responsible for late delivery, loss or damage to the documents.

Hard copies of Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes, with the name and address of the bidder, and be clearly marked **"Tender for Supply and Installation of Pumps and Equipment (MOAF/SPADP/W3/06/2021)"** and must be delivered to the first address below no later than **2:00 p.m. Jamaican time on September 17, 2021**. Bids will be opened publicly immediately after the deadline for submission of bids on **September 17, 2021 at 2:15 p.m.**, in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at that address. Qualification information only must be submitted simultaneously to the second address below.

Each bid must be accompanied by a "Bid Security" of One Million Eight Hundred Jamaican Dollars (JA\$1,800,000.00) or Twelve Thousand United States Dollars (US\$12,000). Late bids will be rejected.

GOJ/MOAF reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected prospective bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected prospective bidder(s) of the grounds for GOJ/MOAF action. GOJ will not defray any costs incurred by any bidder in the preparation of bids.

The Borrower intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract for the upgrade/improvement of the Government's Information and Communications Technology Infrastructure. Payments by the Bank will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Loan Contract. Payments will be made only at the request of the Borrower and upon approval by the Bank in accordance with the terms and conditions of the financing contract between the Borrower and the Bank. No party other than the Borrower shall derive any rights from the Loan Contract or have any claim to the funds.

The OPM now invites bids from eligible bidders for Provision, Installation and Configuration of an e-Gate Solution for the Passport, Immigration and Citizenship Agency (PICA), Jamaica.

Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies for Procurement of Works and Goods financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN2349-9), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined.
