The Statistical Institute of Jamaica (STATIN) is a statutory body and has responsibility, as mandated under the Statistics (Amendment) Act, 1984, for the collection, compilation, analysis, abstraction and publication of statistical information relating to Jamaica. STATIN's core technical functions are the production of economic, social and environment statistics. STATIN produces accurate and timely information in keeping with its enacting legislation and in accordance with regional and international standards, thereby supporting the planning and strategic processes for stakeholders such as the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service, the Bank of Jamaica, the Planning Institute of Jamaica, ministries, departments and agencies of the Government of Jamaica, the private sector, academia, regional and international bodies. The various users need different data, ranging from data sets of varying detail by commodity to aggregated figures. The Administrative Statistics Division is responsible for producing and disseminating international merchandise trade statistics (IMTS). The International Merchandise Trade Statistics provide data on the movement of goods between Jamaica and the Rest of The World.

The Statistical Institute of Jamaica now invites eligible technical consultancy services firms to submit their bids of proposal for the procurement of Technical Consultancy services for gathering Functional and Business requirements for a new Trade Processing System.
