INVITATION TO BID

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) – United Kingdom Caribbean Infrastructure Partnership Fund (UKCIF), in an amount equivalent to £16,710,313 towards the cost of the Southern Plains Agricultural Development Project (SPAD) and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries (MoAF), Southern Plains Agricultural Development Project (SPADP), now invited sealed bids from eligible and qualified Bidders for the Supply and Installation of Pipelines, Fittings and Meters, and Construction of Farm Access Roads, Drains and Flood Protection Works – Parnassus (MOAF/SPADP/ W2-W4A/06/2021).

Firms whether bidding individually or in the form of a Joint Venture shall:

- (a) Be legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in an Eligible Country;
(b) Be more than fifty (50) per cent beneficially owned by a citizen or citizens and/or a bona fide resident or residents of an Eligible Country, or by a body corporate or bodies meeting these requirements, as far as the ownership can be reasonably determined;
(c) Have no arrangement and undertake not to make any arrangement whereby the majority of the financial benefits of the contract, i.e. more than fifty (50) per cent of the value of the contract, will accrue or be paid to subcontractors or sub-consultants that are not from an Eligible Country; and
(d) In all cases, not be subject to any restrictions under European Council Regulation No 2580/2001 of 27 December 2001 or the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) 2009 of the UK with a view to combating terrorism.

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.

Eligible bidders will be required to submit full qualification information with their bids establishing their eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Tender and qualification information are to be submitted in the English Language on the prescribed forms inserted in the Bid Documents.

Bid documents will be available for inspection at the first address below, from July 5, 2021, on weekdays between 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. Jamaican time. A complete set of bidding documents can be requested by interested bidders via email at SPADProcurement@nicjamaica.com.

The documents will be promptly issued in soft copy, but under no circumstance will GOJ SPADP, or MOAF be held responsible for late delivery, loss or damage to the documents.

Hard copies of Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes, with the name and address of the bidder, and be clearly marked "Tender for the Supply and Installation of Pipelines, Fittings and Meters, and Construction of Farm Access Roads, Drains and Flood Protection Works – Parnassus (MOAF/SPADP/W2-W4A/07/2021)" and must be delivered to the first address below no later than 2:00 p.m. Jamaica time on September 27, 2021.

Each bid must be accompanied by a "Bid Security" of Ten Million Jamaican Dollars (JA\$10,000,000.00) or Sixty-Six Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty-Six United States Dollars (US\$66,666.00). Late bids will be rejected.

GOJ/MOAF reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected prospective bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected prospective bidder(s) of the grounds for GOJ/MOAF action.

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received a grant through the World Bank (WB) under the Pilot Programme for Climate Resilience (PPCR) towards the cost of implementing the Improving Climate Data and Information Management Project (ICDIMP). The objective is to improve the quality and use of climate-related data and information for effective planning and action at the local and national levels.

The objective of the consultancy is to develop a continuity plan for the MSJ-SAON consisting of Automatic Weather Stations (AWSs). The plan will include standard operating procedures (SOPs) for operations, management and safeguard of AWSs during hurricanes or other extreme weather events.

The Planning Institute of Jamaica now invites eligible individuals to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy services by submitting their curriculum vitae (CV) demonstrating the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services (description of similar assignments undertaken). The selection criteria are:

At least 5 years' Experience in meteorology
At least 8 years' experience in the installation and maintenance of Automatic Weather Stations (AWSs)
Experience in capacity building and the ability to interface with Government officials.
The consultant should have excellent communication skills, excellent knowledge of the English language (both spoken and written).
