The Office of the Prime Minister (OPM), acting on behalf of the Government of Jamaica (hereinafter called "Borrower"), has received financing (hereinafter called "funds") in the amount equivalent to US\$68,000,000.00 from the Inter-American Development Bank (hereinafter called "the Bank") towards the cost of the implementation of 4437/OC-JA - National Identification System Project.

The OPM now invites bids from eligible bidders for Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Solution for the Registrar General's Department.

Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies for Procurement of Works and Goods financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN2349-9), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined.

Eligibility for Bid Submission

To establish eligibility, Bidders must comply with the following criteria at the time of bid submission:

- 1. First Stage Bid Form completed and signed;
2. Valid copy of Certificate of Incorporation;
3. Proof of certification from manufacturer(s) to implement and support the systems being proposed OR Declaration of ownership of the system being proposed signed by a Notary Public.
4. Copy of Joint Venture Agreement, if making submission as a Joint Venture;
5. Bidder is from an IDB Member country.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents via the GOJ's e-GP Procurement System at https://gojep.gov.jm on October 11, 2021.

Bids are to be submitted electronically via the GOJ's e-GP Procurement System at https://gojep.gov.jm by 3:00 p.m. local time on November 30, 2021.

Tender opening will be done electronically on the same day at 3:15 p.m. local time. An online bid opening report will be sent to all Bidders who submit a proposal. A bid security will not be required.

The OPM reserves the right to terminate the procurement process and reject all submissions at any time prior to the award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to any of the bidders.

The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) intends to enter into a loan agreement with the World Bank towards Additional Financing for the Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project, and has committed counterpart financing to achieve the Project's objectives. The GoJ intends to apply part of the counterpart financing for the following consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services")

Jamaica's Trade Facilitation Reform Programme is (TFRP) being implemented against the background of the GOJ's Public Sector Transformation and Modernization Programme (PSTMP), which builds on previous efforts to reform the public sector. The Trade Facilitation Reform Agenda is being executed through a coordinated framework with the Ministry of Industry, Investment and Commerce (MIIC) serving as lead Ministry with oversight for implementation of the TFRP. The Trade Facilitation Task Force (TF2), through its secretariat, which resides within the Trade Unit of MIIC, leads implementation. The following positions are now being procured to establish a Project Management Office:
