The consulting services ("the Services")

The National Competitiveness Council (NCC) is a public-private sector body chaired by the Minister of Industry, Investment and Commerce (MIIC), with support from the Jamaica Promotions Corporation (JAMPRO) as the Technical Secretariat. The NCC works with various agencies across Government to identify, implement and monitor reforms geared at improving Jamaica's business environment. The Council's efforts at improving the investment climate is driven by the reforms outlined in the Business Environment Reform Agenda (BERA). The BERA includes projects being implemented with other sources of funding by over 20 Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) in a comprehensive process of reprioritization, re-engineering and reform. The Project Management Officer will work within the governance framework of the PMO and ultimately is required to assist in the implementation of the Business Environment Reform Agenda (BERA) in a seamless and efficient manner through strategic stakeholder management, effective contract support and proactive technical input.

The intended commencement date is January 2022 and the anticipated duration of each assignment is twenty-four (24) months.
