The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project (FCGP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services")

The National Competitiveness Council (NCC) is a public-private partnership body established in 2010 to advance policy advocacy, research and public awareness of reform initiatives that facilitate the creation of an enabling environment for businesses in Jamaica. In acknowledging the importance of total factor productivity and its correlation with competitiveness, the NCC established a National Productivity Subcommittee to identify reforms that could lead to improvement in Productivity with an emphasis on total factor productivity. The objective of this assignment is to assess the current labour productivity environment in Jamaica and develop a framework and roadmap to be implemented by public and private sector entities to significantly increase the country's productivity indices.

The anticipated duration of the assignment is six (6) months.

The Planning Institute of Jamaica now invites eligible individuals ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the services. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Selection of Individual Consultants method set out in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 (revised in November 2017, July 2018 and November 2020) ("Procurement Regulations").
